Prof. Luis Moura has been graduated in Medicine at Abel Salazar Biomedical Sciences Institute of Oporto University (1991). He has completed the Cardiology training and fellowship at São João's University Hospital (Oporto) and then moved to the Division of Cardiovascular Medicine of Complutense University of Madrid, where he has stayed for 2 years (9/02- 03/04).

He was a Research and Post-Doctoral Fellow at the Echocardiography laboratory (Director: José Zamorano, MD, PhD).

He completed the PhD in Medicine/ Cardiology at Madrid Complutense University in 2007.

At the present he is a Senior Cardiology Attending at the Hospital Pedro Hispano (Oporto) and Assistant Professor of Cardiovascular Medicine at Oporto University Medical School.

He is vice-chairman of the working group of echocardiography of Portuguese Society of Cardiology (2004-pres).

He is the author and co-author of over 20 papers, most published in peer-reviewed international journals, over 100 presentations, original or invited, at the main scientific events.

He is member of several scientific societies, national and international.

He was granted several awards and honours, including: "Bolsista da Fundação Ciência e Tecnologia" (2003-2004), Cardiology Portuguese Society (1999-2000 and 2002-2004) and Cardiology Portuguese Society/AstraZeneca Foundation (2008) among others.
