MODERATED POSTER PRESENTERS GUIDELINES

Your poster has been chosen for its outstanding quality and will be discussed in a specific area during the Poster Moderated session chaired by two moderators.

The session will start with moderators viewing each of the posters, presenters then briefly summarize their poster to the audience and moderators. A question-and-answer period of 2 minutes follows each presentation.

Set up and Technical information for moderated poster.

A date and 6 minute time slot has been assigned for presentation of your poster during this session - Please ensure you are available for the entire duration of the coffee-break (beyond the 6 minutes allocated to your poster)

Set up:

If your presentation is in the morning your poster must be set up between 08:00 and 08:30, removed between 12:30 and 13:00 and be on display from 08:30 until 12:30. You or one of your co-authors must be present throughout the coffee break (10:00-11:00) in order to discuss the poster.

If your presentation is in the afternoon your poster must be set up between 13:30 and 14:00, removed between 18:00 and 18:30 and be on display between 14:00 and 18:00. You or one of your co-authors should be present throughout the coffee break (15:30-16:30) in order to discuss the poster.

Technical information:

Poster board information: Portrait 2,30m (height) x 0m90 (width) black background with Velcro suitable

Please note these dimensions and keep for when you prepare your poster.

Suggestion: Design your poster layout in the following sections:

Title, author(s), address (at upper edge, across the width of whole poster)

Purpose

Methods

Results

Conclusions

Recommended sketch of poster:

The title should be emphasized by the use of bold-face type. When displayed the letters used should not be smaller than 15mm.

The subtitle should be printed in the same kind of lettering, but semi-bold and not less than 10mm high when displayed. This guarantees clear reading even from a distance of 2-3 meters. The text should be broken up by the inclusion of drawings and/or photos. The use of colour makes the poster more attractive and effective.
