Educational challenges

- The diversity of the national societies in Europe

- The wide range of specialties and work task – what is the standard
- The US. Comparison: Registered Cathlab Interventional Specialists – Is it possible and desired in Europe
- Linguistic matters
- Economic and financial aspects

Budget proposal

- An estimation of the cost for launching a ESCel platform for N&AP
- Funding for 2-4 one day meetings every year for 6-8 people
- Meeting activities for a EAPCI meeting during EuroPCR
