General CV (as it pertains to PCI)

Professor of Cardiology since March 1st 2002 of the CardioThoracic Department of the University of Pisa.

I performed the following research stages: Nationa Heart Hospital and King's College Hospital, London in 1984 (subject: myocardial biopsy and its interpretation); Catheterization Laboratory of the Cardiologic Department of University of Verona in 1990-91 (in order to learn how to practice PTCA); Catheterization Laboratory of San Diego in 1994 (subject: coronary stents); Catheterization Laboratory of New York in 1994 (subject: aterectomy) .

Since 1993 I am Responsible of the Catheterization Laboratory of the Cardiac and Thoracic Dpt. of the University of Pisa, where I work as interventional cardiologist performing all types of diagnostic procedures, endomyocardial biopsy, conventional coronary angioplasty, peripheral angioplasty, stenting, directional and rotational atherotomy, primary and rescue coronary angioplasty, interventional procedures with distal protection devices, high-risk interventional procedures with circulatory support through femoro-femoral cardiopulmonary by-pass, interventricular septum alcoholization, intravascular and intracardiac ultrasound and intracoronary echocontrastography and OCT; percutaneus aortic implant, PFO closure. Carotid angioplasty. Valve implantation and mitral regurgitation correction.
