


Q3 Have you ever cited EP wire reports as references in your articles/presentations?






Q6 Do you think EP wires subjects are a realistic representation of clinical issues cardiologists/electrophysiologists are faced with?







Q7 How often do you reply to the monthly EP wire surveys?





Q8 Do EP wire results influence your clinical practice ?










Q13 Are you encouraged by your National Society to respond to these EP wires?






