- 15 million individuals at risk (+2.5%/y)
- 140,000 CV deaths
- 25% of cardiologists >60 yrs

200 **new** cardiologists / year

240 **retiring** cardiologists / year

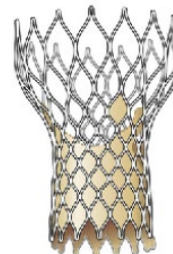

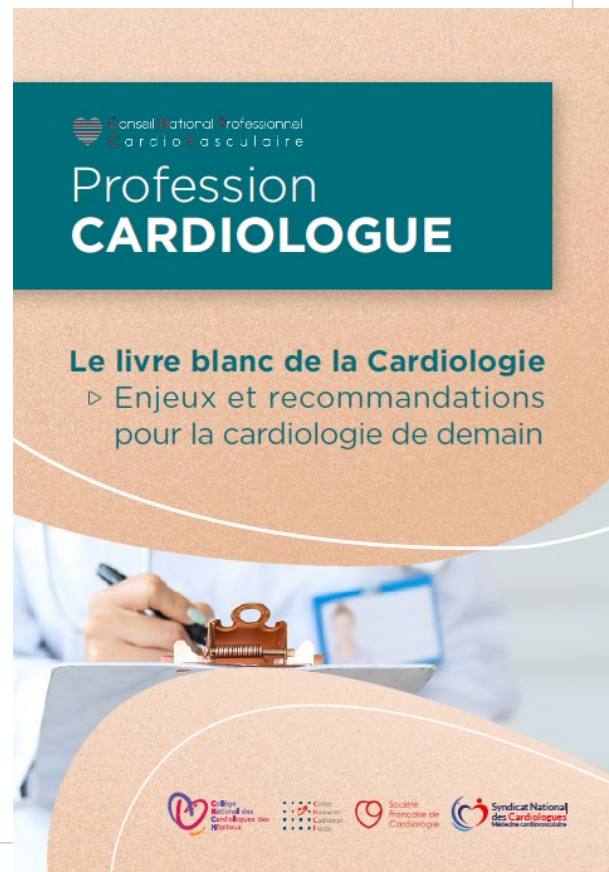
