Gerhard Hindricks is a researcher and cardiologist from Berlin, Germany. The main areas of scientific interest include arrhythmias and electrophysiology, particularly interventional treatment of cardiac arrhythmias, new innovative technologies and device therapies. Furthermore, Gerhard was/is principal investigator for various large-scale and guideline relevant clinical trials in the field of cardiac arrhythmia.

He has published more than 800 peer-reviewed scientific manuscripts. Gerhard is principal investigator of the European Commission sponsored PROFID project, one of the largest global activities on the prevention of sudden cardiac death.

He was the President of European Heart Rhythm Association, Chairman of ESC atrial fibrillation guideline task force, chaired various program committees of international congresses and was Editor-in-Chief of the Europace Journal. Currently, Gerhard is a member of the Digital Health Committee of the European Society of Cardiology. Gerhard is the Chief integration Officer of the German Heart Center of the Charite and has been appointed as Director of the Department of Cardiology of the Charite Campus Mitte on February 1st, 2024.
