Suleman Aktaa, PhD is a Fellow of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) who led the development of the ESC quality indicators for cardiovascular disease, their integration with the ESC registries and application in clinical practice. He completed his PhD at the University of Leeds, and his thesis was entitled: Improving cardiovascular care and outcomes: cross-boundary clinical registries and quality indicators.

Dr Aktaa has a special interest in implementation science and the adaptation of data-driven strategies that aim to increase efficiency in health care, whilst improving patient care. He has published extensively in this field and authored the 'Administration and data collection' chapter of the PCR-EAPCI Textbook. Percutaneous interventional cardiovascular medicine.

He has been awarded the British Cardiovascular Intervention Society (BCIS) coronary and structural intervention Fellowship to the University of British Columbia in Canada, and selected in the Emerging Leaders Programme of the British Cardiovascular Society.
