



Prof. Piotr JANKOWSKI, Poland

Piotr Jankowski is a cardiologist specializing in cardiovascular prevention. His main topics of scientific interest relate to cardiovascular prevention, hypertension, hypercholesterolemia, mechanisms of aging and atherosclerosis development. Currently he serves as a professor at the Centre of Postgraduate Medical Education in Warsaw and at the Jagiellonian University in Kraków (Poland). He is the head of Department of Internal Medicine and Geriatric Cardiology in Warsaw. Secretary (2017-2019) and member of the Board (2011-2015, 2017-2019) of the Polish Cardiac Society, chairman of the Health Promotion Committee of the Polish Cardiac Society (2011-2017 and 2021-2023), chairman of the Working Group on Epidemiology and Prevention of the Polish Cardiac Society (2009-2011), appointed National CVD Prevention Coordinator for Poland (since 2010), member of the EAPC Prevention Implementation Committee (since 2018), chairman of the Board of the Public Health Foundation (since 2018), member of the Board of the Krakow Association of Physicians (2011-2023). Author of over 470 scientific contributions, co-author of a number of scientific and clinical statements and guidelines. Laureate of numerous scientific awards (among others: Award of the Minister of Health, Awards of the Polish Cardiac Society, Polish Society of Hypertension, European Society of Hypertension, "Health Promotion" Foundation, "Honoris Gratia" Award). Member of editorial boards and reviewer in a number of national and international scientific journals including EHJ, EJPC, Lancet, BMJ, Hypertension, Journal of Hypertension, and Atherosclerosis.
