Technical recommendations

<p>This digital event is accessible on PCs, tablets and smartphones, however using a smartphone is not recommended due to screen size</p>	
<p>The better your internet connection is, the better the audio/video quality will be. You can test your internet speeds here. Upload speeds below 0.5Mbps will not be sufficient</p>	
<p>In case of a problem, the first thing to do is refresh your web page</p>	
<p>Using Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox or Safari is recommended. Using Internet Explorer or old versions of any browser is not suggested</p>	
<p>If you are watching from your workplace, there may be a firewall on the internet connection preventing you from watching the event. If you encounter any problem that is not solved by trying from another browser, please contact your IT service or try connecting from your smartphone</p>	
<p>You may have to deactivate your ad blocker if you have one</p>	
<p>Allow cookies in your browser Settings/Preferences</p>	



The day of the event

Sit in a quiet room	
Mute your computer and phone
