Victoria Johnson was born in Stuttgart, Germany, where she completed her school education before attending Medical School at the Justus-Liebig University in Giessen. She graduated in Medicine in 2013 and continued at the Cardiology Department of Prof. Dr. C. Hamm in Giessen where in 2014 she obtained her Medical PhD Thesis. Her clinical focus is now Electrophysiology. From February 2018 until June 2019 Victoria had a Post-Doc fellowship at the Comprehensive Heart Failure Centre in the University Clinic, Wuerzburg in the department of Prof. Dr. C. Maack. In June 2019 she returned to Giessen to complete her Cardiology Qualification.

After serving two years as Deputy Chair, Victoria is since April 2019 Chair of the "YoungDGK", the Section of Young Cardiologists within the German Cardiac Society.

Since April 2019 Victoria Johnson is the chair of the YoungDGK, the group of young cardiologists within the German Cardiac Society. Also, the YoungDGK has conducted two different academic courses for the young, focusing on special needs in education and networking. Also, through working within the Programme committee the youngDGK have been able to plan European sessions during the German national cardiac congress to foster the cooperation of young cardiologist within Germany and Europe.

Within the ESC Victoria has joined the SpringSummit from 2018 -2020 and also joined the Programme committee for the ESC Conference in Munich.
