The EuroHeart team recently gathered in London on March 16th and 17th for a highly productive meeting. Over the course of two days, team members collaborated closely, sharing valuable insights and advancing key initiatives to strengthen partnerships, refine strategies, and discuss upcoming projects. A restructuration was discussed to enhance national representation and engagement. Therefore, the EuroHeart Steering Committee will be updated into a dedicated forum called the National Leaders Committee. It will include representatives from National Registries and National Leaders from each participating country, The positive momentum generated in London is sure to contribute significantly to the ongoing success of EuroHeart's mission to improve cardiovascular health across Europe.







RELEASE OF THE ANNUAL REPORT


EuroHeart has released its latest annual report, presenting 2024 data in the ACS-PCI network.. This report marks a major milestone in EuroHeart's mission to advance cardiovascular care by offering deeper medical insights and highlighting critical areas for improvement across Europe. It emphasizes a systematic approach that considers age, gender, and diabetes, ensuring more personalised care. Access to detailed data supports evidence-based clinical decisions and allows healthcare systems to learn from each other's strengths and weaknesses.

NORWAY JOINS EUROHEART!


We are pleased to welcome Norway as the 14th country joining the EuroHeart network! It will integrate its Norwegian Myocardial Infarction and Invasive Cardiology registries, which align with EuroHeart's goal to improve cardiovascular care. These government-funded registries, covering PCI and TAVI, have near-complete participation across hospitals and regions, ensuring high data quality. Norway plans to share ACS/PCI data with EuroHeart starting in 2025, with data available by June 2025. The country is open to expanding into other domains like TAVI and participating in research projects.

The Norwegian Society of Cardiology fully supports this collaboration, which is legally and ethically feasible with anonymized data.
