Main activities

- Annual meeting of the JACN
- Support and enhance scientific activity
 - Scientific Journal in Japanese: Journal of Japanese Association of Cardiovascular Nursing
 - Research grant
 - Ethical committee
- Seminar to improve cardiovascular nursing practice, twice a year (about 140 persons)
- Collaboration with other scientific congress: Joint symposium in Japan
- Discussion medical service fee: Home nursing care etc.

2. Challenges & barriers among our nursing community



- The aging society in Japan
 2019: People ≥65 years, 28.4%, People ≥75 years, 13.8%
 2036: People ≥65 years, 33.3%.
- The number of patients with cardiovascular diseases is increasing.
- Improve a home- and community-based care and provide continuity of care
- Need to improve quality of palliative care
- Language barriers. Disseminate important scientific papers in English
- Recruiting new healthcare professionals in the community.



3. Involvement with ACNAP



Key areas to develop for the nursing community

- Regular participation during National Conference Calls
- Implement and disseminate the new knowledge and skills of cardiovascular nursing
- Expand networks for clinical and research nurses
- Collaborative research (e.g., ACNAP survey)
