
Mission & objectives

- Remains in charge for two years works closely with regional representatives of ANMCO (Nurses and Doctors), collaborates with the other ANMCO Working Groups and Task Forces.
- Aim of the NWG is the promotion of good health practices in the field of nursing care, treatment, prevention and rehabilitation of cardiovascular diseases through projects and initiatives aimed at organization of care, training, promotion and carrying out of studies and research, application/implementation of standards and guidelines.

2. Challenges & barriers among our nursing community

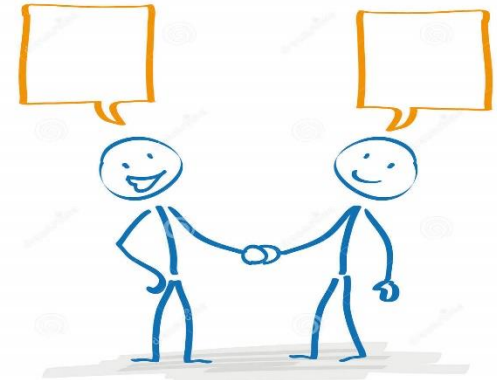
- Support updating with clinical competence courses for nurses
