Career overview	Sabina De Geest, PhD, RN is a Professor of Nursing and Chair of the Department of Public Health of the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Basel (Switzerland). She holds adjunct faculty positions at the Johns Hopkins University, University of Pittsburgh and New York University (USA).
Research focus	She co-leads the Leuven Basel Research Group, an international, interdisciplinary research group focusing on behavioural and psychosocial issues in solid organ & stem cell transplantation. Driven by implementation science methodology, her research portfolio focuses on the development of innovative care models partially powered by eHealth. In addition, her research addresses psychosocial and behavioural pathways and their relation to outcomes in chronic illness and the development and testing of instruments to assess patient reported outcomes. She is one of the founders of the Swiss Implementation Science Network (IMPACT) and



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	leads the patient-reported outcomes part of the Swiss Transplant Cohort Study.
