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### Short CV

Kairat Davletov graduated from the Kazak State Medical Institute in Almaty, Kazakhstan in 1986. After graduation, he worked as cardiologist at the Kazakh Republican Research Institute of Cardiology until 1990, when he moved to the Russian Scientific Cardiology Center, Moscow where in 1994 he completed the PhD thesis in cardiology.

After coming back to Almaty, he worked for the Ministry of Education, Culture and Health as the Head of the Project Implementation Unit, and, later, at the National Center of Healthy Lifestyle, Almaty, where he led the Unit of medico-social program and served as coordinator of the CINDI-Kazakhstan project.

In 2002, he decided to receive the fundamental education in public health, applied and received the US State Department Muskie Fellowship and in 2004 graduated from the Rollins School of Public Health, Emory University, Atlanta, USA, receiving MPH degree.

After graduation, he worked for the American International Health Alliance and, later, at the USAID Central-Asian regional office in Almaty.

In 2013, he re-joined the Republican Research Institute of Cardiology and Internal Diseases in Almaty as a Deputy Director in charge of the strategic development, international cooperation and prevention.
