Professor Sergey Boytsov has served as the Director of the Russian National Research Center for Preventive Medicine of the Russian Ministry of Healthcare since 2011. Dr. S. Boytsov has 33 years of experience in public health practice and is certified in therapy, cardiology and public health. He is a Doctor of Medical Science, a professor, Honored Doctor of the Russian Federation. Dr. Boytsov was awarded with diplomas of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation.

Dr. S. Boytsov's scientific and clinical interests include prevention and treatment of chronic non-communicable diseases (NCDs), cardiology and internal medicine.

Under Dr. S. Boytsov's leadership 14 regions of the Russian Federation currently participate in the multicenter observational study "Epidemiology of Cardiovascular Diseases in the Regions of the Russian Federation", which includes among others assessment of molecular genetics risk factors for NCDs. Also, under his management all regions of the country conduct regular dispensarization (health-check) of the adult population and organise the process of effective clinical supervision of persons with proven high risk of NCDs.

Dr. S. Boytsov directly participated and continues to work on a number of legal and methodological documents. Recommendations for general practitioners and physicians on the prevention of chronic non-communicable diseases were developed by his initiative and under his leadership.
