 - Screening Education Centres
 - Reduction of salt in bread
 - The Rehab Project: Creation of the first CR Centre

Ireland: The Mobile Health Unit (MHU)

- Dr A Brown, NCPC for Ireland, presented the Community Presence Project: Mobile Heath Unit
 - Raise awareness about high blood pressure and risk factors for heart attack and stroke
 - Identify high blood pressure and provide 1-1 lifestyle advice and advise to GP
 - Reach the hard to reach groups in rural and disadvantaged areas
 - Build relationships with key stakeholders
 - Raise pubic profile of MHU & Irish Heart
