## CANDIDATE CODE OF CONDUCT

This document describes the Code of Conduct that must be respected by candidates for an elected position on the EHRA Board or Nominating Committee.

- Candidates for elected positions on the EHRA Board and Nominating Committee must refrain from canvassing activities, such as travelling to meet Constituent Bodies for reasons unrelated to their current ESC activities, or from mailing / e-mailing Constituent Bodies, other than once to communicate their manifesto.
- Candidates for the position of President-Elect will be invited to present their manifesto to the EHRA Nominating Committee.
- Following candidates' selection by the EHRA Nominating Committee, the CVs and letters of motivation of all candidates will be posted on the EHRA elections page of the ESC website.
- At the discretion of the EHRA Nominating Committee, presentation slides of candidates for the position of President-Elect may also be published on the EHRA elections page of the ESC website.
- No other form of campaign activity is allowed during the election period, which starts with the official publication of the final slate to the end of the voting period.
- In case of violation on the part of the candidate, the EHRA Nominating Committee and/or the ESC Ethics Committee will examine the evidence and act accordingly. This may include disqualifying the candidate from standing in the election.
