 - AVNRT min 15, max 25
 - AVRT min 15, max 25
 - RA atrial tachycardias min 5, max 10
 - cavo-tricuspid atrial flutter min10, max 25
 - idiopathic RVOT VT min 5, max 10
 - 50 complex ablation at least 30 of which are atrial fibrillation ablation including transseptal puncture.






