Haran Burri is an electrophysiologist at the Cardiology Department of the University Hospital of Geneva (Switzerland), where he is director of the device program. He graduated from the University of Geneva in medical studies in Geneva in 1992, where he completed his specialization in Internal Medicine and in Cardiology before training in electrophysiology in Lyon (France). He obtained EHRA certification in cardiac pacing in 2006 and in electrophysiology in 2008. His research has focused on device therapy and catheter ablation, with over 130 publications. He is currently Professor at the Medical Faculty of the University of Geneva. He has served on the EHRA Education Committee from 2009-2015, and chaired the committee for the last term. He has also served on the ESC Education Committee and Program Committee, as well as the EHRA Health Economics committee. He is currently President of the Working Group of Pacing and Electrophysiology of the Swiss Society of Cardiology.
