 stands in the city centres, public lectures and health
 checks. Additionally, a brief questionnaire provided by
 the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) and
 translated in Greek was completed by citizens in order
 to assess their knowledge concerning Heart Failure and
 the major risk factors that contribute to the
 disease. (1000 questionnaires were collected and data
 are being analyzed)

HoTWalk Athens 2019



On 27th of May the 3,2km HoTWalk was organized by the Heart Failure Association and the Hellenic Society of Cardiology. It took place at the Acropolis and Plaka area at the end of scientific activities of Heart Failure Congress that was held in Athens, from 25th to 28th of May 2019.

The tour was a great success with more of 450 participants and was open to the general public aiming to incite everyone to get active and enjoy walking at the historical center of Athens, combining health activity with sightseeing. Hundreds of Greek and foreign delegates and members of the general public had the opportunity to walk in the shadow of the Acropolis and take a magical trip through history



This year's HoT Walk will cover a distance of 3,2 klm along Dionysiou Areopagitou Street, a pedestrianized street, adjacent to the south slope of the Acropolis in the Makrygianni district of Athens. It is named after Dionysius the Areopagite, the first Athenian convert to Christianity and patron saint of the city of Athens.

The street runs from east to west. It starts from Amalias Avenue near the Arch of Hadrian and ends near Philopappos Hill where it continues as Apostolou Pavlou Street, the rest of the pedestrian zone which goes around the archaeological site of the Acropolis and the Agora.
