Electronic voting – process



- The ESC electronic voting process was established and successfully used during the **2018** ESC elections for board members, audit committee and nominating committee members.
- For the 2020 ESC Election electronic voting process, the ESC has again asked the supplier <u>"Election Europe"</u> to set up the voting platform, notify voters of the process in May and send them a personal password, which is then used to vote.
- This password can only be used once by each voter.
- The electronic voting platform will open for voters **8 a.m. on June 1st 2020 and close on June 26th 2020 at 18:00 p.m**. The electronic voting via the Internet will constitute the exclusive means of expressing the votes.
- In the event of technical questions from voters, these are sent to the **Chair of the Nominating Committee** and forwarded to Election Europe and Celine Allegre.
