FY18 – Budget building context



- External environment is changing (MedTech code...) and related uncertainty calls for a conservative approach
- ESC Group budget aims at a **break-even** net financial result, thus the need to closely monitor and collectively stabilize expenses
- Implementation of a "top-down" approach with objectives given for each EHH business units (incl. Associations)
- In FY18 the Associations' annual contribution (estimated flat fee: 90K€) from ESC stopped and was replaced by indirect general and administrative costs (G&A) according to predefined allocation keys and based on volume of respective activities from the past 3 fiscal years
- Budget was built with projects classified into three categories: must do, want to do and like to do


