



## **Terms and Conditions for the Support of Scientific Events "endorsed by the EACVI (Type 3)"**

(According to the Terminology and Rules to Catalogue Different Types of Support for Scientific Events by the EACVI, revised version, January 2016)

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### **General Terms:**

For all supported meetings endorsed by the EACVI, the following general terms apply:

- Events may not overlap with the annual ESC and EACVI congresses. EACVI promotional material and literature will be displayed at the event.
- EACVI logo and branding guidelines must be respected. All items on which the EACVI logo is used need approval by the EACVI Secretariat ([EACVI@escardio.org](mailto:EACVI@escardio.org)) prior to publication.
- EBAC or equivalent national accreditation is required.
- EACVI support is granted to an individual scientific event. If similar events occur in a series or are regularly repeated (ex: yearly edition), support must be asked for each individual event separately.
- The event is endorsed by the EACVI but is organised without the involvement of the EACVI.



### **Specific Terms for Events endorsed by the EACVI (Type 3)**

- The event must fulfil the following criteria:
  - International meeting or national meeting of supra-regional importance.
  - International profiles of speakers
  - Recognised scientific value, relevance and competence in the field of echocardiography
  - At least 80% of the programme concerns non-invasive imaging
  - No conflict of interest (not primarily profit-driven, no single-company sponsoring)
- EACVI will ask an administrative fee of €500 EUR + applicable VAT (a letter of agreement will be issued between the EACVI and the event organiser).
- Events may be promoted with the remark "Endorsed by the EACVI".
- EACVI Logo is provided.
- EACVI will provide limited promotion (inclusion in the World Cardio Agenda and Imaging calendar on the ESC website)
- No financial or administrative support from the EACVI.
