### **Short CV for Dr P. Nihoyannopoulos, MD, FRCP**

Qualified from medical school in Strasbourg-France in 1979 (Universite Louis Pasteur). Trained in Cardiology at Hammersmith Hospital (1984-88). Lecturer in Cardiology 1988-1991. Senior Lecturer and Honorary Consultant Cardiologist in 1991. In 1999, I was conferred the title of Reader in Cardiology at Imperial College and in 2006 I was elected Professor of Cardiology at Hammersmith Hospital and Imperial College London. I am clinical Firm leader for treating patients with all sorts of heart disease as well as leading my research team in a variety of research programs.

I have published more that 160 full papers in peer review journals, more than 300 abstracts and more than 20 book chapters. I am fellow to the American College of Cardiology, American Heart Association, Royal College of Physicians, European Society of Cardiology. I served as President of the British Society of Echocardiography (2001-2003) and I am now the President of the European Association of Echocardiography of the ESC.

My particular areas or research is in the study of ventricular function using modern technology with ultrasound. I was one of the pioneers of stress echocardiography in the UK in the early 80s. I currently hold several research grants for the study of heart muscle disease with Tissue Doppler and the use of contrast microbubbles for detecting myocardial perfusion and inflammation. I am also devoted to teaching both, under- and post-graduate medical students while I am invited lecturer and visiting Professor in several universities around the world.
