What would you like to achieve if you were elected?

I have a strong belief in the value of the EAPCI. I already have a number of themes for the EAPCI for the coming years.





- I want to be in a smooth continuity of action with the previous presidents and boards.
- -Full commitment to the Education Program by developing the VITAL principles and PCR seminars in local languages. We also need to strengthen the Fellowship Programs. It is our duty and privilege to work with our industrial partners on subjects of education and innovation, but our scientific independence is our primary asset.
- -Promoting the active involvement of young and female colleagues in the EAPCI, through working groups, with caps on consecutive terms in Committee positions.
- Listening to and acting upon suggestions and questions from national Working Group delegates, particularly at the EAPCI Spring Summit.
- In collaboration with the national Working Groups, setting up short-term registries dedicated to critical issues.
- -Strong involvement of the EAPCI in drawing up ESC guidelines and consensus papers on specific medical devices and treatments. At European level, I intend to advocate in favor of the patient's information and access to the treatments recommended in the guidelines, and to fight against inequality in access to care.

I would consider it a great honor to have your confidence in leading the EAPCI for the coming years 2020 and 2021. I greatly look forward to it, with your support!

If you were elected, how do you envisage to organize yourself to accommodate this very demanding additional commitment?

Since 2016, I have been President-Elect and in 2018-19 will be President of the French Society of Cardiology. I have learned how to organize my working life in the University of Brest so as to be able to carry on performing cardiac procedures, consultations and imaging without skimping on any of my commitments in our scientific Society.
