What would you like to achieve if you were elected?

1. To enhance European collaboration in the evaluation and integration of new interventional strategies, especially including the smaller EAPCI partner countries. This should also include the creation of a database of scientific centers willing to conduct multicenter trials on certain topics.
2. To strengthen the role of EAPCI for the contribution to ESC guidelines related to topics of interventional cardiology as well as within the ESC organization additional to the annual ESC congress and the Euro Heart Survey program.
3. To even further develop EuroPCR as the official annual EAPCI meeting as the worlds number 1 educational cardiovascular meeting.
4. To further establish and support existing European collaborative structures for young interventional cardiologists to improve their knowledge and skills, potentially including exchange programs with cardiosurgical institutions to broaden the view of interventional cardiology also to cardiac surgery.
5. To strongly support the freshly established WIN initiative supporting female interventional cardiologists.

6. To further develop an unbiased and fruitful partnership and collaboration with industry partners to address unmet needs on both sides.
7. To broadly discuss the needs of different EAPCI membership countries in order to establish pathways for the integration of interventional techniques into practice.
8. Finally, to continuously support the ongoing key topics of EAPCI such as "Stent-for-life" initiative, the educational efforts such as the ESC eLearning platform, the fellowship programs, the EuroIntervention Journal and the PCR/EAPCI Textbook on Percutaneous Cardiovascular Medicine
